LEASE INSPECTION OF ARMSTRONG PETROLEUM CORPORATION LEASES IN THE WEST NEWPORT FIELD

On September 8, 2016, Division of Oil, Gas, and Geothermal Resources (Division) Engineering Geologist Raul Lima, and Energy and Mineral Resources Engineer Stacy Sor conducted a lease inspection at Armstrong Petroleum Company's "Banning", "Hank 2 Lease", and "Pacific Electric" leases in the West Newport oil field. This letter itemizes violations of California's Public Resources Code (PRC) and California Code of Regulations (CCR) based upon observations made during the lease inspection.

CCR section 1722.1.1(a) States that "Each well location shall have posted in a conspicuous place a clearly visible, legible, permanently affixed sign with the name of the operator, name or number of the lease, and number of the well. These signs shall be maintained on the premises from the time drilling operations cease until the well is plugged and abandoned."

The well sings at the listed wells do not identify the current operator. Armstrong Petroleum Corp. must install a sign identifying the current operator by November 21, 2016, and notify the Division so that Division personnel can confirm that the violations have been corrected.

Inadequate Well Cellar Covers CCR section 1777(c)(3)states that "Well cellars shall be covered and kept drained. Grating or flooring shall be installed and maintained in good condition so as to exclude people and animals. Cellars should be protected from as much runoff water as practical."

The well cellars for the listed wells are not covered properly. Armstrong Petroleum Corp. must repair the well cellars for the listed wells so that they are in good condition and exclude people and animals by November 21, 2016, and notify the Division so that Division personnel can confirm that the violations have been corrected.

Fluids in Well Cellars CCR section 1777(c)(3) states that "Well cellars shall be covered and kept drained. Grating or flooring shall be installed and maintained in good condition so as to exclude people and animals. Cellars should be protected from as much runoff water as practical."

The well cellars for the listed wells contain fluids. Armstrong Petroleum Corp. must drain the well cellars for the listed wells; repair the piping, wellhead equipment, and/or wells so that fluids do not accumulate in the well cellars by November 21, 2016; and notify the Division so that Division personnel can confirm that the violations have been corrected.

Failed Zonal Isolation CCR section 1777(a) states that "Production facilities, including flow lines and wellheads, shall be maintained properly to prevent leakage and protect life, health, property, and natural resources."

Fluids were observed to be bubbling in the well cellar of this well and the well casing was observed to be moving from side to side indicating inadequate zonal isolation. Armstrong Petroleum Corp. must conduct appropriate mechanical integrity testing of this well to identify the depth of damaged casing and/or cement, either repair the failed casing and/or cement or abandon the well by November 21, 2016, and notify the Division so that Division personnel can confirm that the violation has been corrected.

Unremediated Spill CCR section 1777(a) states that "Operators shall maintain production facilities in good condition and in a manner to prevent leakage or corrosion and to safeguard life, health, property, and natural resources."

CCR section 1775(a) states "Oilfield wastes, including but not limited to oil, water, chemicals, mud, and cement, shall be disposed of in such a manner as not to cause damage to life, health, property, freshwater aquifer's or surface waters, or natural resources, or be a menace to public safety. Disposal sites for oilfield wastes shall also conform to State Water Resources Control Board and appropriate California Regional Water Quality Control Board regulations."

Soil adjacent to the pumping units and well heads of the listed wells are stained by unremediated spills. Armstrong Petroleum Corp. must clean up the unremediated spills by November 21, 2016, and notify the Division so that Division personnel can confirm that the violations have been corrected.

Failure to comply with the laws of California and this Division may result in enforcement action including, but not limited to, issuance of a civil penalty and/or order pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 3106, 3224, 3235 and 3236.5.
